Aspire and the NDIS

The NDIS is a new way of providing individualised support for people with permanent and significant disability, their families and carers.

This means that instead of providing support based on the number of places available in a support program, the NDIS provides individualised funding.

This means people can get the care and support they need, based on their individual support needs, goals and aspirations.

The National Disability Insurance Scheme (NDIS) commenced in the Albury Region from 1 July 2017. In the Wodonga and surrounding areas the commencement date was 1 October 2017.

With the introduction of the NDIS, Aspire is focused on:

- Helping you better understand the changes that are happening with the introduction of the NDIS
- Providing information to help you through those changes
- Keeping you updated on the different ways that Aspire can help you

This focus is reflective of Aspire's Mission to work alongside people with disabilities and their families to achieve their goals and aspirations.
