

Short-term Accommodation House (Children)

Providing planned short-term accommodation for children aged 6– 17 years of age with a disability, with a focus on developing social skills and learning basic life skills.

The Children's Respite House is open seven days per week, including weekends, school and public holidays.

Unless special circumstances apply, staff are not rostered on between the hours of 9.00am to 3.00pm weekdays.

Facilities

Facilities in the house include:

- Five beds (two of which are hi/low electric beds)
- Wheelchair access
- Two bathrooms
- Two living areas
- Electric hoist to assist with manual handling needs
- Spacious backyard with undercover play area
- Wheelchair bus

Transport and School

An accessible vehicle is located at the house to transport children during their stay. However, transport to normal school programs need to

be organised by the child's carer.

Aspire can assist carers to arrange transport to school via community managed transport, taxis or public transport.
